one penny red believes in sourcing wines from growers who make wine with integrity and have respect for the land. In many cases the winemaking approach in the vineyard is sustainable, organic and/or biodynamic. These wines are labour intensive and made by hand, some by conventional means others by adopting a minimal intervention approach where its common place to allow fermentations to occur naturally with indigenous wild yeasts. There are wines that have low or no sulphur dioxide added, others are not fined or filtered.

Mostly these wines are fresh and alive, and love being enjoyed with food to show off their personality.

We hope you enjoy our selection of these hand crafted wines and take away the experience of trying something delicious and accessible.

**The Coravin® system**

*The Coravin® system is a unique wine preservation system. It allows us to offer wine by the glass from our best bottles. No removal of foil or cork is required in order to access the wine, just a thin, hollow needle is inserted through the cork to extract the wine; at the same time an odourless and tasteless argon gas is inserted into the bottle to replace the space created by the extracted wine.*

## georgian wine

The alluring wines of Pheasant's Tears are fermented and aged in qvevri, a unique Georgian vessel used to ferment and store wine. Qvevri were the first vessels ever to be used for wine fermentation, with archaeological finds dating back to 6000 BC. Qvevri are clay vessels lined with beeswax and completely buried under the ground where the temperature stays even throughout the year.

This white wine is golden amber in the glass with a nose of honey, but dry and unexpectedly full-bodied in the mouth with notes of walnut and apricot.

### ***Adriana Occhipinti, Vittoria.***

*In her early 20s, Adrian began making wines in her home area of Vittoria, Sicily. Frappato amazed her: a grape capable of making floral, elegant reds, so different from the big, ripe overpowering Nero d'Avolas that had so far defined Sicilian wine. Her first vintage was released in 2006 when she was just 24. At the time she had just one hectare of vines. This red wine sp68 is basically a blend of 70% Frapatto, 30% Nero d'Avola, 10–15 days on skins and then 6 months in stainless steel. Vivid colour. Lovely pure, floral nose is very fine. Fresh palate with pretty cherry fruit and some grip resulting in a fragrant, elegant, structured wine with heaps of personality.*

*Jean-Jacque Morel's philosophies are pretty extreme and are so labour intensive that they can only be applied on a small artisan domaine like his. With an annual production of just 650 dozen, he uses no chemicals instead allowing the natural grasses and flora to coexist with the vines, weeding only by hand to keep the vine canopy free of other plants.*

*Whether he is making wine in the Pyrenees' Malakoff vineyard (see Out of Step) or in the hilltops of Castiglione Falletto, Aussie Dave Fletcher is addicted to Nebbiolo! His Langhe X13 blend of Sourced from across Alba, the wine is textbook young Nebbiolo with supporting acting from Cabernet and Merlot, the breakdown is all thirds, yet the Nebbiolo is the standout. It's dark fruit and it's not afraid to show it. Big tannins, ripe fruit, dark cocoa and barrel spice please your palate. This is a smash and grab Langhe Rosso experience, ultimately classy and supremely structured Nebbiolo.*

### **La Violetta Wines, Great Southern.**

*La Violetta is the project of AJ Hoadley, inspired by the diversity and nuance found in the vineyards and sub-regions of Great Southern. The Up! fruit is sourced from one of the oldest vineyards in the region, its hand harvested, then destemmed without crushing. The name of the wine is a suffix commonly found in place names in Western Australia's south-west, meaning "place of" in the indigenous Noongar dialect. With its dense cedar scents from the 14months of seasoned oak it is enhanced with the perfume of red berries and earthy mineral notes. Its dusty, savoury and refreshing palate has a lovely mouthfeel proving an excellent expression of the region.*
